
These are the base patterns for each face mask. Each piece is marked with a pattern number as well as a description of which mask it is for and the color felt to be used.


Print each page onto freezer paper to make the patterns. Cut out each pattern box and fuse onto your felt.


Cut each base out and set aside. There should be 12 bases.































These are the remaining pattern pieces for each mask. Each piece is marked with a pattern number as well as a description of which mask it is for and the color felt to be used. I have organized the pieces in boxes by color.


Print each page onto freezer paper to make the patterns. Cut out each pattern box. Cut a piece of Heat-N-Bond the size of each pattern box.

Fuse the Heat-n-Bond onto the piece of felt needed for your piece. For example, you need a piece of heat-n-bond 7 x 4 ½" for Baby Jesus's face. Fuse the Heat-n-Bond to a piece of light peach felt. Now cut around the Heat-n-Bond. Next place the box with the pattern onto the opposite side of the felt and fuse in place. You will have the pattern on one side, the felt in the middle and the Heat-n-Bond on the bottom.














